







Lanzarote Airport was **certified by the Spanish Aviation Agency (AESA), according to EU 139/2014 regulation.**



The airport got **‘The Voice of the customer’** recognition by **ACI World** in 2021.



Lanzarote Airport has **Level 2 certification** under **ACI Europe’s Airport Carbon Accreditation Programme** for its reduced carbon footprint.

As part of the environmental initiatives that CM Lanzarote Airport is implementing, it boosts sustainable transport (including the development of a cycle path), it has acquired new electric vehicles and installed high energy efficient fans for improving the comfort.
