Since 22 June 2018, she has held the post of General Technical Secretary for the Ministry of Public Works (currently the Ministry of Transport, Mobility and Urban Agenda), assisting the Minister and the Under-secretary in coordinating services.

From February 2010 to June 2018, she held the position of Deputy Director General of Inspection and Auditing in the Public Accounts Department, being responsible for planning and coordinating prior legal compliance checks in different areas of public expenditure, as well as proposing resolutions to discrepancies raised in the exercise of the aforementioned checks.

From 2003 to January 2010, she held other positions within the Sub-Directorate General for Inspection and Auditing, being National Auditor Area Director, carrying out functions related to the position of Deputy Assistant Director, and before that, the position of Deputy Assistant Director and Head of Intersectoral Area.

From February 2002 to March 2003, she was Head of Area in the Audit Office of the Ministry of Science and Technology and Financial Controller for the Spanish Patent and Trademark Office, carrying out prior auditing of expenditures, verifying investments, attending Contracting Committees and Boards, and carrying out duties related to the auditing of accounts and ongoing financial control in the Agency.

She has sat on the Boards of Directors of CETARSA and RUMASA.
