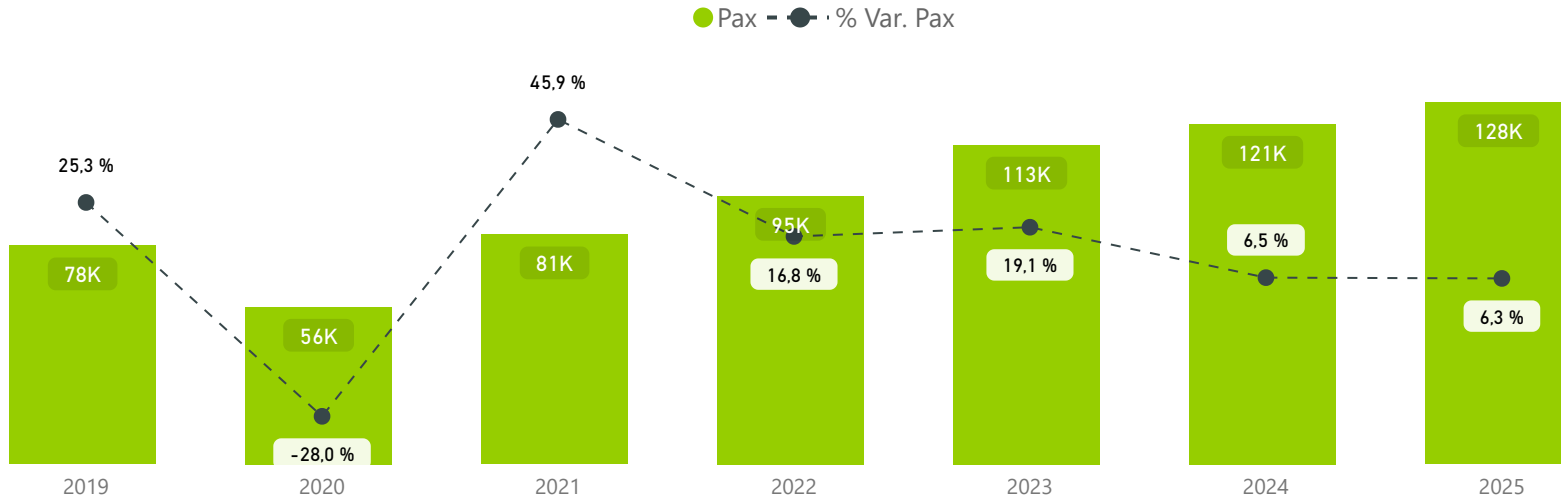

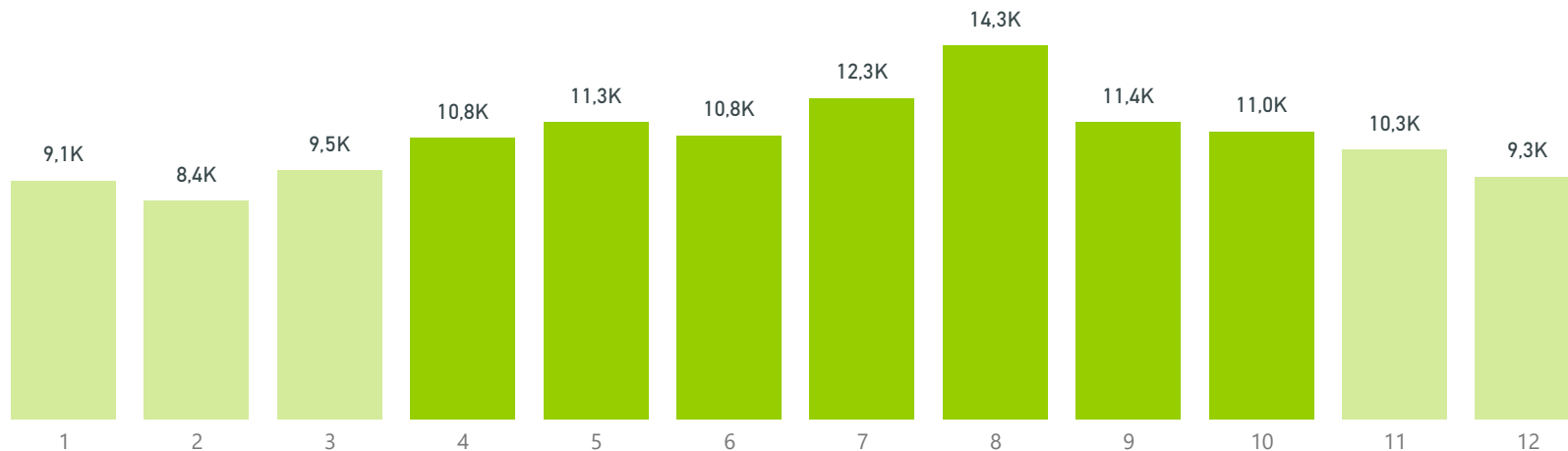

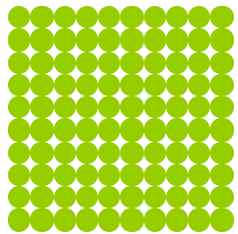

Traffic distribution



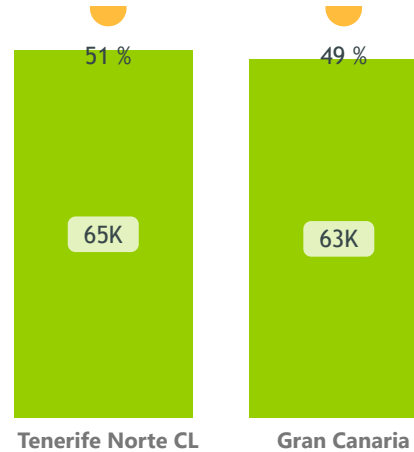

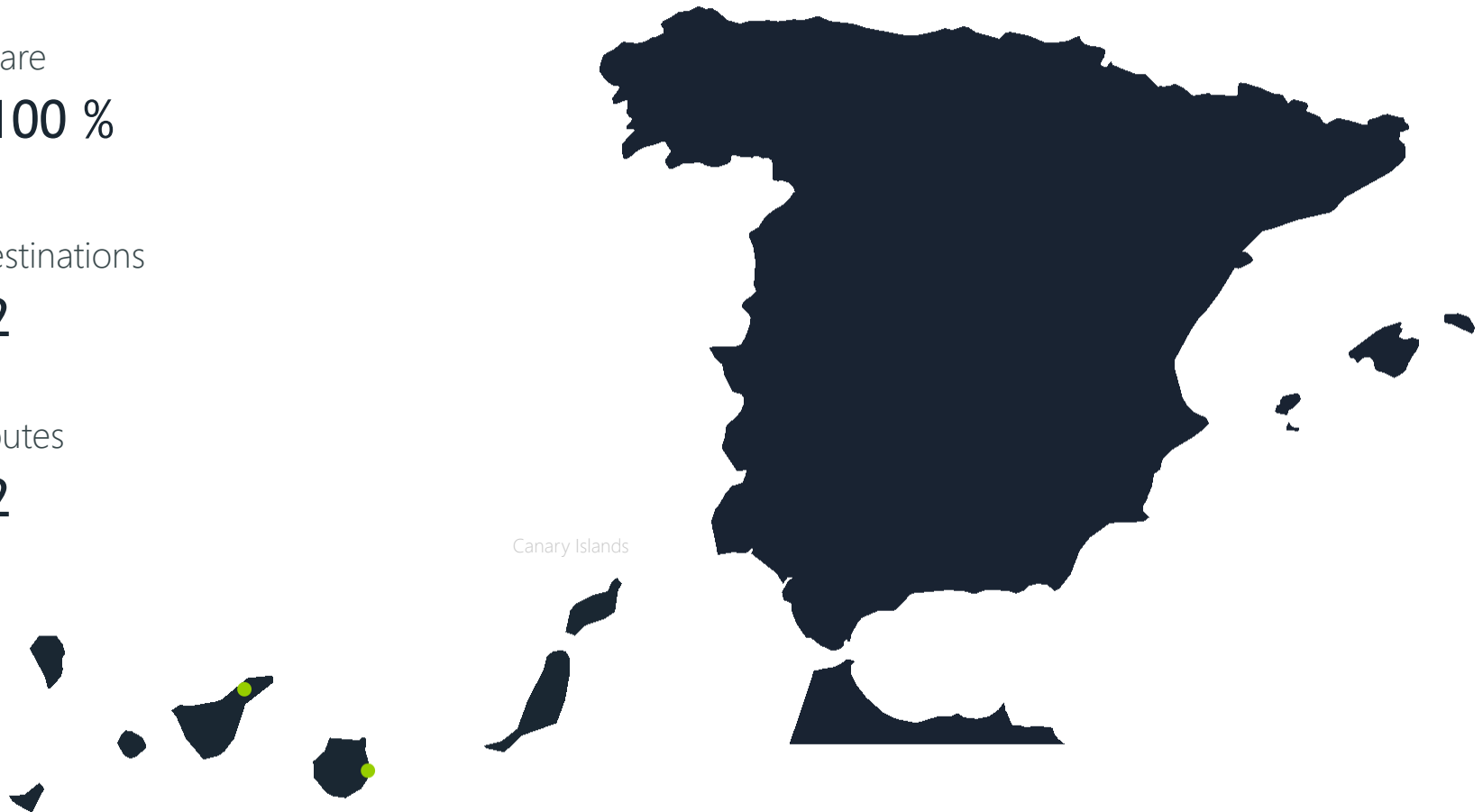

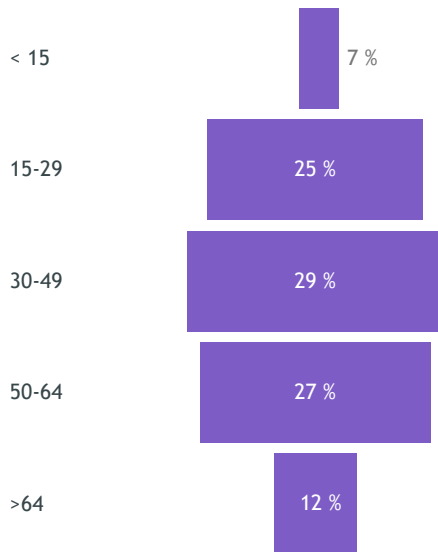
