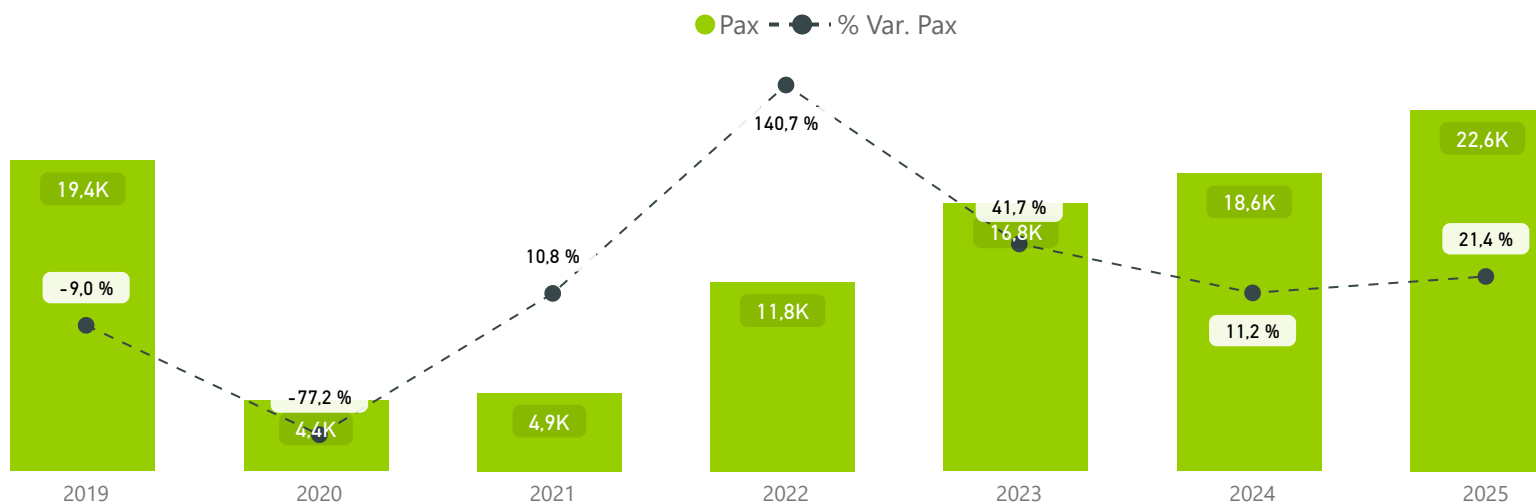

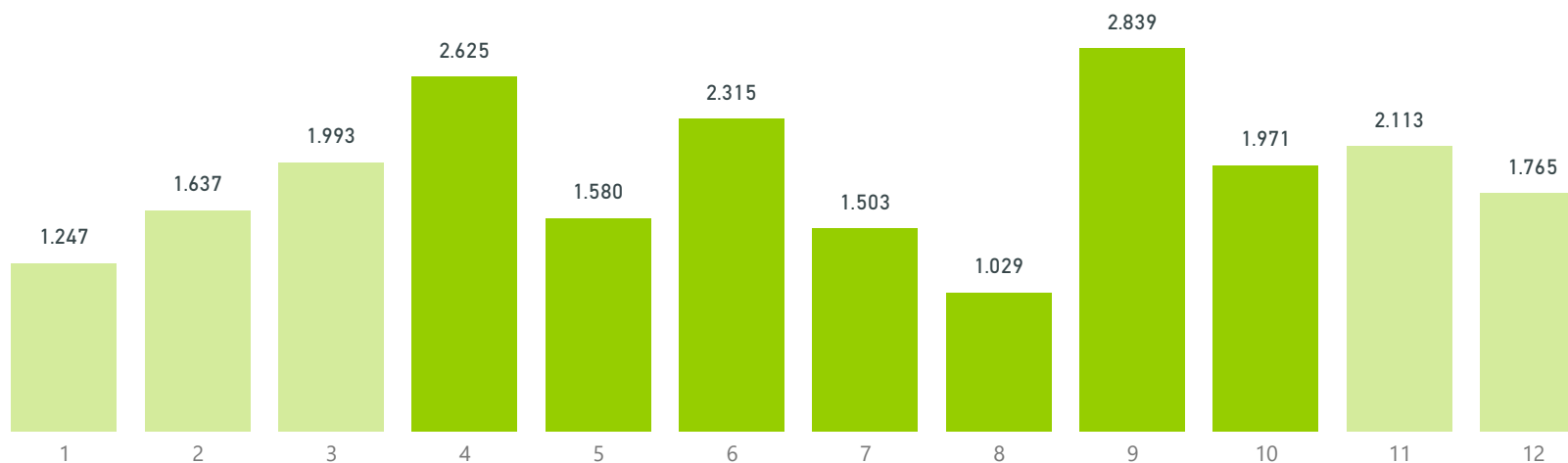

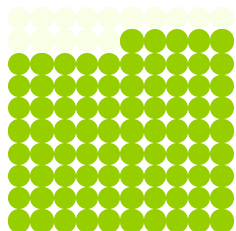

In 2025, Aena achieved an A, the highest possible rating, on the climate change questionnaire.

#### Dow Jones Sustainability Index
